
Evaluation for ______9/25

Overall, you increased in confidence because you're speaking significantly more sentences per minute which shows a higher comfort level in speaking. Pronunciation mistakes dropped by about 50% which is excellent. Grammar mistakes increased a bit, though that is also reflective of speaking more. Overall, your communication improved by about 1.78 on a 6 point scale which is very good.
